



Instructions for Authors

The Alliance Newsletter is the publication of the Gambling and Public Health Alliance International. It was established to provide a forum for sharing and disseminating information internationally keeping members up-to-date with worldwide developments in legislation, policy and programmes. It facilitates and encourages debate and provides members with an invaluable network to acquire knowledge to utilise in the task of reducing gambling harm.

The articles have a public health approach to problem gambling. The Alliance brings together people from around the world who are dedicated to reducing and eliminating gambling related harm. The newsletter has an international scope and is intended for a broad audience that includes clinicians, health promoters, researchers and policy makers, and other interested parties.

The Alliance Newsletter is published in English and provides information on the public health approach to minimising gambling harm.

- *Feature Articles* (1000-1500 words).
- *Brief Reports* (500-1000 words).
- *Letters* (fewer than 300 words)

Manuscript Preparation

Include full names of authors, contact emails, and name of organisation. Submit a disclosure note with your article listing any institutional or commercial affiliations or association that may pose a conflict of interest.

Articles should address the subject of problem gambling from a public health perspective and appeal to a broad audience. Because of the international nature of the readership, clarity is especially important: articles should be concise and clearly written. Well-chosen subtitles, tables, and figures will enhance presentation.

Double-space everything, including the title page, references, tables and figure legends. Articles should be submitted electronically, with pages numbered, beginning with the title page. Indent paragraphs five spaces; leave no extra space between paragraphs.

Please make sure the article is fully referenced and place references in numerical order at the end of the article, with a maximum of 10 references.

As articles remain the ownership of the author they will be accompanied with a disclaimer stating that 'the views expressed within the newsletter are those of the author/s and do not necessarily represent or reflect the views, policies or actions of the Alliance.' The author is responsible for ensuring that submitted manuscripts are free of copyright and any other encumbrance that would preclude publication.
